Martin Miller became interested in antiques shortly after leaving school. Searching in vain for a guide to prices he decided to create his own, with his then business partner. The first Lyle Antiques Review, forerunner to the famous Miller's Antiques Price Guide, was born in 1969.

He has a refreshingly unstuffy attitude to antiques and people which explains his love for restoring interesting old properties, stuffing them with ancient objects, and sharing them with friends and guests. These included Chilston Park, the 17th century hotel in Kent, a gothic mansion in Kensington and a Victorian maisonette in Notting Hill.

His latest project is Glencot House, a Victorian mansion built in grand Jacobean style. Nestling beneath the Mendips at Somerset's Wookey Hole it's given him a fresh opportunity to enjoy the company of those who think the present is over-rated!

Meursault 1er Cru Les Perrieres, Domaine Jean-Michel Gaunoux 2002</b><br/>Burgundy, France<br/>Generous, toasted almond nose with overtones of honey. Full bodied and very complex in the mid palate with a silk texture entwined with ripe fruit and buttery oak and a clean, mineral finish.</p>  | <p><b>£60.00</b></p>  |
| <p><b>51. Brunello di Montalcino Riserva, Fattoria dei Barbi 2000</b><br/>Tuscany, Italy<br/>Brick red in colour with earthy brown edges. The nose is pronounced and complex, offering an array of red and black berry fruits, spices and oaky aromas. The palate is medium to full bodied with a richly complex middle and an everlasting, elegant finish. The tannic structure that dominated the wine in its youth is beginning to mellow and allow mature, secondary characteristics to show. A stunning wine with enormous appeal.</p> | <p><b>£60.00</b></p>  |
| <p><b>52. Chateau Leoville Barton, 2eme Cru Classé, St Julien 1999</b><br/>Bordeaux, France<br/>Intensely concentrated nose with enormous amounts of tobacco, mocha, liquorice and cassis aromas. The palate is complex and formidably concentrated, with serious structure, fine balance and a defiant finish.</p>   | <p><b>£75.00</b></p>  |
| <p><b>53. Clos de Vougeot Grand Cru, Domaine Robert Arnoux 2001</b><br/>Burgundy, France<br/>Reveals a nose reminiscent of roasted spices and café au lait. This soft, supple, medium to full-bodied, and silky textured wine is seductive and filled with a complex blackberry, cassis, coffee, mocha and spices. A long, firm finish, with glorious fruit.</p>  | <p><b>£95.00</b></p>  |
| <p><b>54. Perrier Jouet, Belle Epoque 1996</b><br/>Champagne, France<br/>And initial lively freshness leads to rounded palate that displays notes of honey, vanilla and short bread right through the long, long finish. Truly inspiring.</p>   | <p><b>£100.00</b></p> |
| <p><b>55. Krug, Grande Cuvée NV</b><br/>Champagne, France<br/>Undoubtedly the King of Champagne; rich and complex with a toasty, nutty character, fresh lemony acidity and the finest, most delicate bubbles imaginable.</p>  | <p><b>£125.00</b></p> |

- 41. Shiraz Rosé, Indis 2005** £16.50  
**Western Australia** (14.5% abv) **175ml Glass** £4.15  
Mouthfilling concentration of cherry and cranberry fruit flavours alongside mouthwateringly racy acidity with a dry, refreshing finish.
- 42. Chateau Gassier, Côtes de Provence 2005** £17.95  
**Provence, France**  
Deliciously fruity, soft and very easy to drink, finishing crisp and refreshing.

## SPARKLING WINE

- 43. Argeo, Prosecco Brut, Ruggeri NV** £17.95  
**Veneto, Italy** (11% abv) **125ml Glass** £4.00  
A classic, elegant Prosecco with tiny bubbles, a fresh green apple nose and palate and a long, crisp finish.

## CHAMPAGNE

- 44. Comte de Robart Brut, Cuvée de Reserve NV** £36.95  
**Champagne, France Half** **Half Bottle** £18.50  
Fine and fresh, with elegant fruit aromas and flavours.
- 45. Blanc Souverain Pur Chardonnay, Henriot NV** £48.50  
**Champagne, France**  
Intense, complex floral nose with a touch of white fruit. Fruity, sharp, lively, persistent in the mouth with a mainly citrus aftertaste.
- 46. Veuve Clicquot Ponsardin Brut, Yellow Label NV** £49.50  
**Champagne, France**  
Intense aromas that are fruity at first, then floral and slightly musky. Fresh and fruity on the palate with lingering apple and pear notes.
- 47. Bollinger, Special Cuvée NV** £54.50  
**Champagne, France**  
Rich, toasty and full bodied, with wonderful concentration and depth of flavour. Many Champagne houses aspire to this style but few succeed as well as Bollinger.

## DESSERT WINES

- 48. Muscat de Rivesaltes, Domaine Cazes 2004** **Half Bottle** £16.95  
**Languedoc Roussillon, France**  
Rounded, rich and sweet with honeyed apricot fruit balanced by limey acidity that keeps it fresh through to the soft finish.
- 49. Clos Dady, Sauternes 2003** **Half Bottle** £23.95  
**Bordeaux, France**  
Luscious and generous with sweet apricot, honey, roasted nut and marmalade flavours, perfectly balanced by a zesty, lime rind acidity.

## WHITE WINES

- 12. Sauvignon Blanc, Mansion House Bay 2006** £21.95  
**Marlborough, New Zealand**  
Medium to full bodied with vibrant acidity intertwined with crisp fruits. Finishes zesty and long.
- 13. Chablis, Domaine de Vauroux 2004** £23.50  
**Burgundy, France**  
Medium bodied with crisp, apple acidity, tight, pure fruit flavours of white peaches and pears, and a classic, steely, dry finish.
- 14. Gavi di Gavi, Fontanafredda 2006** £23.50  
**Piemonte, Italy**  
Attractively young, dry and well-balanced with fresh, flinty acidity and a delicate, elegant, floral bouquet.
- 15. Pouilly Fume, Chateau Favray 2005** £24.95  
**Loire, France**  
A round, lush wine with good depth of fruit, fantastic concentration and superb balance. Clean, crisp, citrus style fruit and mineral notes.
- 16. Chardonnay, Thelema Mountain Vineyards 2004** £26.95  
**Stellenbosch, South Africa**  
Medium to full bodied with a creamy texture. Packed with luscious tropical fruit notes, a delicious mineral streak and nutty oak. Finishes soft and succulent.
- 17. Chablis 1er Cru Montmain, Domaine Pico Race 2004** £29.95  
**Burgundy, France**  
Excellent Chardonnay bouquet showing subtlety and breed together with a firm underlying richness. The wine is well balanced and has an intricate combination of fruit and acidity. This is classic Chablis of an unusually high quality.
- 18. Chorey Les Beaune Blanc, Domaine Maillard 2005** £34.95  
**Burgundy, France**  
This wine displays classic aromas of toast and grilled nuts on the nose. On the palate it is minerally, with lovely buttery overtones. A classic white Burgundy.

## WHITE WINES - HALF BOTTLES

- 19. Pinot Bianco/Pinot Grigio del Veneto, Delibori 2006** £7.50  
**Veneto, Italy**  
The Pinot Bianco offers ripe green fruit character and aroma while the Pinot Grigio balances the acidity and adds complexity with some steely, mineral tones. Dry, crisp with a refreshing finish.
- 20. Chablis, Domaine de Vauroux 2004** £12.50  
**Burgundy, France**  
Aromatic with clean mineral notes and hints of citrus. The palate is medium bodied with crisp, appley acidity, tight, pure fruit flavours of white peach and pears finished with a classic, steely, dry finish. Stylish.

## RED WINES

- 21. Cabernet / Petit Verdot, Ashbury Grove 2004** £13.75  
**South Eastern Australia** (14% abv) 175ml Glass £3.50  
Fruit forward in style, with a fresh, juicy palate showing a touch of cassis and menthol.
- 22. St. Chinian, Domaine du Barres 2006** £13.75  
**Languedoc Roussillon, France** (13% abv) 175ml Glass £3.50  
This wine displays plenty of ripe mulberry fruit on the nose and palate with soft tannins and a generous finish.
- 23. Merlot, De Gras 2005/06** £14.75  
**Colchagua Valley, Chile** (14% abv) 175ml Glass £3.65  
Mouthfilling, with ripe raspberries and blackcurrants, a firm structure and soft tannins; distinctly Chilean in style.
- 24. Chateau Le Payral, Bergerac Rouge 2004** £14.75  
**Bergerac, France**  
Spicy, with rich, soft, red berry fruits on the nose that follow through to the palate with generous ripe fruit and herby tones.
- 25. Malbec, Bodegas Santa Ana 2006** £15.95  
**Mendoza, Argentina**  
Medium bodied and dry with soft, ripe blackcurrant flavours and a balancing structure, finishing rounded and juicy.
- 26. Bardolino Classico, I Roveri, Le Vigne 2006** £16.50  
**Veneto, Italy**  
Vibrant ruby red colour, with forward red cherry fruit flavours and a hint of spice. The finish is beautifully balanced and complex.
- 27. Shiraz, Indis 2004** £16.50  
**Western Australia**  
A complex, richly flavoured palate with red berry flavours, attractive pepper and spice notes, soft tannins and understated oak.
- 28. Chateau La Freynelle Merlot Cabernet, Bordeaux 2005** £16.95  
**Bordeaux, France**  
A well balanced red offering ripe, spicy fruit and savoury characters with a long, elegant finish.
- 29. Synergy Pinot Noir, Richard Hamilton 2006** £17.50  
**South Australia**  
Bright crimson in colour with a bouquet of black cherries, mushrooms and wild strawberries. The palate has ripe strawberry and cherry flavours with good complexity, a rich juicy mid-palate, fine tannins and a long, clean finish.
- 30. Carmenere Reserva, De Gras 2005** £18.95  
**Colchagua Valley, Chile**  
A full bouquet of spice, oak and black fruit precedes a firm but juicy palate of plum and currant characters alongside well integrated toasty oak.

## RED WINES

- 31. Fleurie, Louis Tete 2005** £21.95  
**Beaujolais, France**  
Juicy, ripe sweetness, cherry and chocolate flavours and a raspberry finish, with a touch of spiciness.
- 32. Hut Block Cabernet, Richard Hamilton 2003** £22.95  
**South Australia**  
Deeply coloured with ripe berry flavours and a full, rich, robust; palate balanced with a supple structure and a fine, dry finish.
- 33. Pinot Noir, Trinity Hill 2004** £23.50  
**Hawkes Bay, New Zealand**  
Classic, varietal characteristics such as plums, blackcurrants and cherries are evident in this silky textured wine, entwined with earthy, smoky oak notes.
- 34. Château Pey La Tour Reserve, Bordeaux Supérieur 2004** £23.50  
**Bordeaux, France**  
Tasty and rich, with surprising concentration, good purity and depth, a low acidity and plump fleshy fruit. Solid in the mouth with excellent length.
- 35. Rioja Reserva, Marques de Arienzo 2000/01** £24.95  
**Rioja, Spain**  
Cherry red with brick red tones. The bouquet is spicy cherry and plum aromas blending with notes of tobacco and wood. The body is full and powerful, with an excellent balance between wood and fruit.
- 36. Merlot, Thelema Mountain Vineyards 2004** £26.95  
**Stellenbosch, South Africa**  
The palate is juicy, broad and ripe, packed with red and black berry fruits, a firm, well integrated oaky structure.
- 37. Chateauneuf du Pape, Domaine Chante Cigale 2003** £34.95  
**Rhone, France**  
Wonderful aromas of spice and dark fruit. Rich and ripe with layers of fruit and spice supported by fine tannins.
- 38. Barolo, Fontanafredda 2001** £35.95  
**Piemonte, Italy**  
Classic dark 'tar' and perfumed 'roses' on the nose, light in colour but with great power, concentration and well balanced, ripe tannins. This is a wine to match with rich foods and game dishes.
- 39. Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Umani Ronchi 2005** £7.50  
**Abruzzo, Italy**  
Medium bodied and dry and with a finely textured structure to support the ripe plummy fruit.
- 40. Chateau des Gravieres, Collection Prestige, Graves 2003** £12.50  
**Bordeaux, France**  
Deep garnet-red with a slightly woody and toasted nose and aromas of prunes and liquorice. Fleshy, robust and well-balanced in the mouth with a firm, lengthy finish.
